

The Crooked Road Virginia License Plate Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How much will the specialty Crooked Road license plate cost?

A: \$25 annually for a standard plate. \$35 annually for a personalized plate.

Q: Does this cost include my vehicle registration fees?

A: No, you must pay your vehicle registration fee with the Virginia Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) when it becomes due.

Q: Can I get the International Symbol of Access (ISA aka wheelchair) on this special plate?

A: Yes, if you have one on your current plate. It will reduce the number of characters by one.

Q: If I want to personalize my Crooked Road plate, how many letters or numbers can I use?

A: You may use up to 6 characters (letters and/or numbers). If you have a disabled plate you may use up to 5 characters.

Q: Can I transfer the personalized license plate number I currently have to the new Crooked Road plate?

A: Yes, if it has 6 or less characters (letters and/or numbers) for a standard plate or 5 or less characters if you have an ISA symbol on your plate.

Q: Will I receive a refund if The Crooked Road is unable to collect the minimum prepaid applications needed to develop this plate?

A: Yes, you will receive a full refund which will be disbursed by The Crooked Road, not DMV.

Q: How long will it take to receive my new Crooked Road plates?

A: It takes up to nine months after DMV receives the applications (between July 1st and July 30th of the year of authorization). The Crooked Road license plate is expected to be available in 2018 or 2019.

Q: Is there an application form for the Crooked Road plates?

A: Yes, The Crooked Road can provide the form to you by email or a hard copy.

Q: Who do I send the completed application form to?

A: The completed application along with a check in the required amount (\$25 for The Crooked Road specialty plate or \$35 if requesting a personalized Crooked Road specialty plate) made payable to The Crooked Road must be mailed to The Crooked Road, One Heartwood Circle, Abingdon, VA 24210.

Q: Will I receive new decals with my new plates?

A: Yes, DMV will issue and mail new decals and vehicle registration along with your new license plates.

Q: Will The Crooked Road derive some benefit from this special license plate?

A: Yes, after the first 1,000 qualifying plates are sold, The Crooked Road will receive \$15 of every \$25 plate fee collected.
